Summary

This special edition of the Statistical Bulletin presents tourism data for 2022 and the recovery in tourism activity.

- International tourist arrivals worldwide in 2022 decreased by -37% relative to 2019, compared to -69% in 2021. More than 900 million tourists travelled internationally in 2022, double those in 2021, though still 37% fewer than in 2019.
- Greece's performance improved significantly, with inbound travel flows decreased by -11.2% compared to 2019 and amounting to 27.8 million visitors, down from 31.3 million visitors in 2019. Furthermore, travel receipts decreased by just -3.0% compared to 2019 and amounted to €17.6 billion, compared to €18.2 billion in 2019, due to an increase in the Spending per Person (SPP) of +9.7% in 2022 compared to 2019 (from €564 to €619).
- This, among other things, was due to a change in the mix of arrivals in favour of international airport arrivals, which have the highest SPP and saw a marginal decrease of -0.2% (there were 21.4 million international airport arrivals in 2022, compared to 21.5 million in 2019). Maritime arrivals from Italy decreased by -19% in 2022 (1.2 million passengers compared to 1.5 million in 2019), while road arrivals which have the lowest SPP decreased by -35.2% (8.0 million in 2021 compared to 12.3 million in 2019).
- It is noteworthy that of the €547.5 million less in revenues in 2022, compared to those in 2019, €392.1 million was due to the loss of the Russian market and €91.3 million to a decrease in cruises, amounting to €483.4 million overall. As regards all other activity, revenues were down from 2019 by just €64.1 million.
- With regard to destinations and in relation to 2019, a significant increase was noted in airport arrivals at the Sun and Beach designations (Crete +5.8%, Dodecanese +7%, Ionian +12.7% and Cyclades +33%), while a marked decrease was noted at others (Athens -13.4%, Thessaloniki -15.6%, Peloponnese -11.9%).
- The increase in demand for Sea and Beach destinations is reflected in the clear improvement in demand indicators from the 2nd quarter onward and particularly during the 3rd quarter (compared to 2019: decreased airport arrivals up to and including June, and then increasing; reduction in domestic maritime arrivals in all quarters, except the third, when there was an increase; and lastly, hotel revenues showed a negative change at the start of the year, which became positive from May onward).
- From EU27 markets, receipts from euro area residents amounted to €8,020 million, up by +3.7%% from 2019, while receipts from residents outside the euro area came to €1,959 million, for a decrease of -2.0%.




- As for non-EU countries, receipts from the USA also increased, by +0.6%, and came to €1,196 million and from the United Kingdom by +21.8%, amounting to €3,123 million.
- In 2022, cruise ship arrivals were estimated at 4,775, compared to 3,979 arrivals in 2019, for an increase of +20%. By contrast, passenger estimates came to 4.6 million visitor arrivals, compared to 5.5 million arrivals in 2019, for a decrease in visitor arrivals of -17%. In other words, a significant decrease in the number of passengers per cruise ship is noted.
- With regard to domestic tourism, airport arrivals decreased by -6.9% and maritime arrivals by -8.0%, both compared to 2019.
- The hotel quality assessment for 2022 remained quite high (with a Global Review Index [GRI] of 87.0% and a Net Promoter Score [NPS] of 50), at the same levels as in 2019 (with 87.1% and 50 respectively).
- At the peak of the tourist season (Q3) in 2022, employment in the accommodation and food services sector (445 thousand employees) exceeded the corresponding level of 2019 (429 thousand employees).
- Lastly, revenues from car rentals in 2022 amounted to €185 million, down -29% in comparison with 2019.



1 Introduction

International tourist arrivals worldwide in 2022 decreased by -37% relative to 2019, though in 2021 they were down -69%. More than 900 million tourists travelled internationally in 2022, double those in 2021, though still 37% fewer than in 2019. International tourism saw better-than-expected results in 2022 due to considerable latent demand and the lifting or relaxation of travel restrictions in a large number of countries.

International tourism recovered by 63% compared to pre-pandemic levels, with Europe and the Middle East leading the way. As the predominant destination in the world, Europe had 585 million arrivals in 2022 to reach 79% of the pre-pandemic level (-21% compared to 2019). The Middle East had the strongest increase amongst destinations in 2022, with arrivals coming to 83% of the pre-pandemic level (down -17% from 2019). Africa and America recovered to about 65% of their pre-pandemic visitor levels, while Asia and the Pacific came to just 23% due to stringent restrictions. By subregion, West Europe (87%) and the Caribbean (84%) came close to pre-pandemic levels. There was a strong recovery in tourist expenditures in 2022, resulting in an upturn in receipts to pre-pandemic levels at many destinations.



Based on the UNWTO scenarios for 2023, international tourist arrivals could be as high as 80% to 95% of pre-pandemic levels. Nevertheless, significant risks remain, particularly economic and geopolitical.

In the period January-December 2022, 21.4 million international airport arrivals were recorded, showing a decrease of -0.2%/-47 thousand arrivals compared to the period January-December 2019, when 21.5 million international airport arrivals were recorded. (*Table 1*).

In the first quarter of 2022, international airport arrivals showed a significant decline. Specifically, 178 thousand arrivals were recorded in January, for a decrease of -52.6%/-198 thousand compared to 2019; 223 thousand arrivals were recorded in February, a decrease of -37.8%/-136 thousand; and 340 thousand were recorded in March, a decrease of -31.4%/-155 thousand arrivals.

The decline slowed at the start of the second quarter, as the decrease in April amounted to -10.1%/-125 thousand and 1.1 million international airport arrivals were recorded. A similar picture emerged in May, when 2.2 million international airport arrivals were recorded and the decrease came to -8.1%/-191 thousand. June recorded an increase for the first time in 2022 (+1.3%/+42 thousand), with 3.3 million international airport arrivals recorded.

The third quarter began with an increase, coming to +8.7%/+337 thousand in July, with 4.2 million international arrivals recorded. In August, 4.0 million international airport arrivals were recorded, with the increase amounting to +4.2%/+160 thousand arrivals. In September, the rate of recovery slowed down to +3.2%/+98 thousand, while 3.2 million international airport arrivals were recorded.



The fourth quarter began with the highest increase recorded in 2022 (+12.2%/+204 thousand), as October saw 1.9 million international airport arrivals. In November, the recovery rate slowed down to -12.6%/-67 thousand and 464 thousand international airport arrivals were recorded. Finally, in December, the recovery rate came to -3.6%/-16 thousand, while 436 thousand international airport arrivals were recorded.

Over the period January-December 2022, the majority of airports saw an increase, compared to the same period in 2019. Conversely, 5.6 million international airport arrivals were recorded at Athens International Airport, showing a decrease of -13.4%/-860 thousand. A similar picture was presented by Thessaloniki Airport, where 2 million international airport arrivals were recorded, showing a decrease of -15.6%/-366 thousand.

At Heraklion Airport, 3.4 million international airport arrivals were recorded, for an increase of +3.1%/+104 thousand, while Chania Airport showed an increase of +13.6%/+156 thousand, with 1.3 million recorded international airport arrivals.

Rhodes Airport recorded 2.5 million international airport arrivals, showing an increase of +8.8%/+205 thousand. At Kos Airport, an increase of +5.2%/+61 thousand was recorded, with 1.2 million international airport arrivals, while Karpathos Airport had 88 thousand international airport arrivals, for a decrease of -11.1%/-11 thousand.

Corfu Airport had an increase of +16.0%/+234 thousand, while international airport arrivals came to 1.7 million. At Zakynthos Airport, 903 thousand international airport arrivals were recorded, presenting an increase of +5.4%/+46 thousand. At the airports of Aktio and Kefalonia, 372 thousand and 353 thousand passengers were recorded, showing an increase of +23.7%/+71 thousand and 6.8%/+23 thousand, respectively.

At the airports of Santorini and Mykonos, 745 thousand and 576 thousand passengers were recorded, showing an increase of +43.4%/+225 thousand and +21.6%/+102 thousand, respectively.

Conversely, the airport at Araxos recorded just 49 thousand arrivals, showing a decrease of -41.4%/-35 thousand, while Kalamata Airport recorded 160 thousand arrivals, showing an increase of +4.4%/+7 thousand.



In Samos, a decrease of -9.2%/-13 thousand was recorded, and in Kavala, -18.1%/-22 thousand, while international airport arrivals came to 125 thousand and 101 thousand, respectively. At Skiathos Airport, 221 thousand arrivals were recorded, showing a decrease of +21.2%/+39 thousand.

Finally, the fewest international airport arrivals for 2022 (only 47 thousand) were recorded at Lesvos Airport, which showed a decrease (-20.5%/-12 thousand arrivals).

International airport arrivals at regional airports amounted to 15.9 million and an increase of 5.4%/+813 thousand, as increases were recorded at most regional units. In terms of absolute differences, the greatest increase was recorded for the Ionian Islands (+12.7%/+374 thousand), as international airport arrivals came to 3.3 million. This was followed by the Cyclades, where airport arrivals amounted to 1.3



million, for an increase of +33.0%/+328 thousand. An increase of +5.8%/+259 thousand was recorded in the regional unit of Crete, and 4.7 million airport arrivals were recorded. In the Dodecanese, airport arrivals came to 3.9 million for an increase of +7.0%/+255 thousand.

Conversely, Peloponnese was the only regional unit to record a decrease (-11.9%/-28 thousand passengers) with airport arrivals amounting to 210 thousand for 2022 (*Table 2*).

The international airport arrivals of the top 5 airports make up 70.7% of the total (*Chart 2*). More specifically, Athens welcomed 25.9% of inbound international airport arrivals in 2022. Heraklion was in second place with 15.9%, followed by Rhodes in third place (with 11.9%) and Thessaloniki in fourth place (with 9.2%). These were followed – with a lower percentage – by Corfu with 7.9%.

In sixth place was Chania with 6.0%, in seventh place was Kos with 5.8% and in eighth place was Zakynthos with 4.2%. The top 10 was rounded off with Santorini with 3.5% and Mykonos with 2.7%. The arrivals of the top 10 airports account for 92.9% of the total international airport arrivals in 2022. Lastly, the market share for Aktio came to 1.7%, for Kefalonia to 1.6% and for Skiathos to 1.0%.




Chart2: Airport Market Share

In the period January-December 2022, 8.0 million international road arrivals were recorded, compared to 12.3 million in the period January-December 2019, showing a decrease of -35.2%/-4.3 million. (*Table 3*).

In the first quarter of 2022, road arrivals showed a significant decline. Specifically, only 170 thousand arrivals were recorded in January (showing a decrease of -63.2%/-292 thousand), 175 thousand arrivals were recorded in February (down -61.2%/-276 thousand) and 238 thousand were recorded in March (down -47.7%/-217 thousand arrivals).



The second quarter began with a decrease in April of -51.8%/-343 thousand and only 320 thousand road arrivals recorded. The recovery rate of road arrivals showed – for the first time in 2022 – a significant acceleration in May (-16.3%/-111 thousand), with road arrivals coming to 569 thousand. In June, though, the rate of recovery slowed to -32.2%/-429 thousand, with 905 thousand road arrivals.

In July, more than 1 million road arrivals were recorded for the first time in 2022, with road arrivals coming to 1.5 million and the recovery rate at 27.8%/-585 thousand. In August, 1.8 million road arrivals were recorded, even though the recovery rate slowed by -28.6%/-713 thousand arrivals. In September, the recovery rate slowed down by -40.9%/-661 thousand and 954 thousand road arrivals were recorded.

The fourth quarter started with an upturn in the recovery rate by -39.8%/-352 thousand, while 534 thousand arrivals were recorded in October. In November, road arrivals came to 398 thousand, recording a decrease of -35.3%/-217 thousand road arrivals. Finally, 445 thousand arrivals were recorded in December, showing a decrease of -24.4%/-146 thousand.

Over the period January-December 2022, only 3 border checkpoints saw an increase, compared to 2019. The border checkpoint at Ormenio recorded the largest increase of +84.5%/+230 thousand, with 503 thousand arrivals. At the border checkpoint at Kyprinos, the increase came to +60.2%/+49 thousand, with 131 thousand arrivals. Finally, the increase at the Exochi border checkpoint was +3.3%/+8 thousand, with 239 thousand arrivals.

The largest decrease in absolute terms was recorded in Promachonas (-59.0%/-2.2 million/), with road arrivals coming to 1.5 million. This was followed by the Nymphaea border checkpoint with the largest percentage decrease of -71.0%/-1.2 million, with 476 thousand road arrivals. Finally, a significant decrease of -11.5%/-281 thousand was recorded at the Evzoni border checkpoint, with 2.2 million road arrivals.

In the period January-December 2022 (*Table 4*), a decrease was recorded with regard to all neighbouring countries of origin, as compared to 2019. Specifically, the largest decrease both in absolute terms and percentage change was recorded in arrivals from Bulgaria (-51.3%/-3.1 million), with 3.0 million road arrivals. From North Macedonia, 2.8 million arrivals were recorded, showing a decrease of -15.3%/-496 thousand.

The decrease from Albania came to -21.9%/-423 thousand with 1.5 million recorded road arrivals. Lastly, there were 781 thousand road arrivals from Turkey, with the decrease amounting to -28.1%/-305 thousand.

The international road arrivals of the top 2 border checkpoints make up 46.2% of the total. (Chart 3). Specifically, the Evzoni border checkpoint received 27.0% of inbound road arrivals in 2022 and the Promachonas checkpoint 19.3%. In third place was the Krystallopigi checkpoint with 8.4% and Kipoi was fourth with 8.3%.

These were followed – with lower percentages – by Kakavia with 7.1% and Ormenio with 6.3%. In seventh place was Nymphaea with 5.9%, in eighth place was Niki with 3.9% and in ninth place was Doirani with 3.6%. The Sagiadia and Exochi border checkpoints followed with 3.1% and 3.0%, respectively. The border checkpoint of Kyprinos followed with 1.6% and that of Kastanies with 1.5%.

The border checkpoints of Agios Konstantinos (0.8%) and Mertzani (0.3%) ranked last.




Chart3: Border Checkpoint Market Share

2.3 Maritime flows

2.3.1 The Adriatic¹

It is estimated that, in the Adriatic market, visitor flows decreased by -19% in 2022 compared to 2019, while the estimate for the number of passengers comes to 1.2 million compared to 1.5 million in 2019. (*Table 5*). More specifically, 132 thousand passengers were recorded in the first quarter, showing a -3% decrease compared to 2019, while in the second quarter the decrease in passengers came to -22%, with 254 thousand passengers being recorded. In the third quarter – the high season – the number of passengers was estimated at 622 thousand compared to 841 thousand in 2019, with the decrease estimated at -26%. The passengers of the third quarter made up 51% of total arrivals in 2022. Finally, numbers for the fourth quarter were estimated to be at 2019 levels and the number of passengers at 202 thousand.

2.3.2 Cruise Travel²

In 2022, total cruise ship arrivals exceeded those of 2019, the pre-pandemic reference year. Specifically, ship arrivals are estimated to total 4,775, compared to 3,979 arrivals in 2019, for an increase of +20%. By contrast, estimated passengers come to 4.6 million visitor arrivals, compared to 5.5 million arrivals in 2019, for a decrease in visitor arrivals of -17%.

According to *Table 6*, in 2022, the port of Piraeus welcomed 672 cruise ships carrying 832 thousand passengers, compared to 622 cruise ships with 1.1 million passengers in 2019. The port of Santorini followed with 827 thousand passenger arrivals and 686 cruise ships, compared to 981 thousand arrivals and 592 cruise ships in 2019. The port of Mykonos was in third place, with 686 thousand passenger arrivals and 608 cruise ships, compared to 787 thousand arrivals and 550 cruise ships in 2019. Corfu was in fourth place, with 528 thousand passenger arrivals and 392 cruise ships, compared to 768 thousand arrivals and 420 cruise ships in 2019. Noteworthy is the decrease in the average number of passengers per cruise ship, from 1,395 passengers in 2019, to 959 passengers in 2022.

Rhodes was next with 370 thousand passenger arrivals and 381 cruise ships, compared to 308 thousand arrivals and 258 cruise ships in 2019. The port of Heraklion welcomed 227 cruise ships with 304 thousand passengers in 2022, compared to 204 cruise ships with 307 thousand passengers in 2019. Katakolo was in seventh place, with 251 thousand passenger arrivals and 198 cruise ships, compared to 414 thousand arrivals and 199 cruise ships in 2019. Chania port in 2022 welcomed 121 cruise ships with 180 thousand passengers, compared to 132 cruise ships with 266 thousand passengers in 2019. This was followed by the ports of Kefalonia/Ithaki, with 145 thousand passenger arrivals and 132 cruise ships, compared to 259 thousand arrivals and 133 cruise ships in 2019. Finally, the port of Patmos welcomed 214 cruise ships with 99 thousand passengers in 2022, compared to 156 cruise ships with 113 thousand passengers in 2019.

Flow at all other ports was less than 95 thousand passengers. Compared to 2019, and based on the number of cruise ships, the majority of ports saw an increase in passenger flows. A -7% decrease was recorded at the port of Corfu, and a -1% decrease at the port of Katakolo and the ports of Kefalonia/Ithaki. The results compared to 2019, based on number of passengers, were the opposite, as the majority of ports saw a decrease. An increase (+20%) was only recorded at the port of Rhodes.

In the period January-December 2022 (*Table 7*), 7.6 million domestic arrivals were recorded compared to 8.1 million in the period January-December 2019, showing a decrease of -6.9%/-560 thousand arrivals.

In the first quarter of 2022, domestic airport arrivals recorded a significant decline. Specifically, only 301 thousand arrivals were recorded in January (showing a decrease of -36.7%/-175 thousand), 332 thousand arrivals were recorded in February (down -28.5%/-133 thousand) and 414 thousand were recorded in March (down -24.2%/-132 thousand arrivals).

The second quarter started showing improvement, as the decrease in April came to just -5.9%/-36 thousand, with 567 thousand airport arrivals being recorded. The improvement in the recovery rate of domestic airport arrivals slowed in May, as the decrease came to -12.8%/-93 thousand, with arrivals coming to 632 thousand. In June, the decrease came to -1.1%/-9 thousand and 819 thousand airport arrivals were recorded.

The same rate continued into the third quarter. In July, the decrease came to -1.2%/-11 thousand, with 943 thousand arrivals being recorded. In August, 951 thousand airport arrivals were recorded, with the decrease coming to -2.0%/-19 thousand arrivals. In September, a marginal decrease of -0.5%/-5 thousand was recorded, with 852 thousand airport arrivals.



The last quarter started with October showing an increase in airport arrivals by +2.1%/+15 thousand and 713 thousand airport arrivals being recorded. In November, the recovery continued with the increase coming to +1.8%/+9 thousand and 533 thousand arrivals being recorded. Finally, in December, the increase came to +5.8%/+28 thousand and 520 thousand airport arrivals were recorded.

Athens International Airport welcomed 3.8 million arrivals, showing a decrease of -5.1%/204 million, while at Thessaloniki airport 957 thousand arrivals were recorded, showing a decrease of -10.6%/-114 thousand.

As far as individual regional units are concerned (*Table 8*), the largest decrease was recorded in the Cyclades (-11.3%/-106 thousand) and resulted mainly from Santorini, where a decrease of -127 thousand passengers was recorded (-21.7%). A smaller decrease in both absolute numbers and percentage change, was recorded in Mykonos (-5.8%/-15 thousand passengers). Conversely, Paros saw in increase of +36 thousand passengers (+34.6%). Airport arrivals in the Cyclades in the period January-December 2022 came to 838 thousand compared to 944 thousand in the period January-December 2019.

In Crete, 937 thousand airport arrivals were recorded, showing a decrease of -4.4%/-44 thousand passengers, compared to 980 thousand in the period January-December 2019. More specifically, a decrease of -7.1%/-46 thousand was recorded at Heraklion Airport, while by contrast, Chania Airport recorded a slight increase of 0.9%/+3 thousand passengers.

A decrease of -9.9%/-56 thousand was recorded in the Dodecanese, where 512 thousand airport arrivals were recorded in the period January-December 2022, compared to 568 thousand in the period January-December 2019. In Rhodes, 350 thousand passengers were recorded (-12.6%/-50 thousand), while 128 thousand passengers were recorded in Kos (-7.0%/10 thousand). Conversely, passengers in Karpathos came to 34 thousand for an increase of +12.8%/+4 thousand.

A decrease of -1.1%/-3 thousand passengers was recorded in the Ionian Islands, where airport arrivals in the period January-December 2022 came to 262 thousand compared to 264 thousand in the period January-December 2019. In Corfu, 170 thousand airport arrivals were recorded, showing an increase of +2.2%/+4 thousand passengers. Decreases were recorded at all other airports. Specifically, 45 thousand passengers were recorded in Kefalonia (-4.1%/-2 thousand), while 44 thousand passengers were recorded in Zakynthos (-3.8%/-2 thousand) and 2 thousand passengers in Aktio (-55.8%/-3 thousand).

3.2 Maritime flows ³

Domestic passenger flows are estimated to have decreased by -8% in 2022 compared to 2019, while the estimate for the number of passengers comes to 17.3 million compared to 18.8 million in 2019 (*Table 9*). More specifically, 1.3 million passengers were recorded in the first quarter, showing a decrease of -35% compared to 2019, while in the second quarter 4.5 million passengers were recorded, showing a decrease of -5.0%. In the third quarter – the high season – the number of passengers was estimated at 9.3 million compared to 8.8 million in 2019, for an increase of +5.0%. The passengers of the third quarter account for 53% of the total number of passengers in 2022. Finally, the decrease in the fourth quarter was estimated at -31% and the number of passengers was estimated at 2.2 million compared to 3.2 million in 2019.

4 Balance of Travel Services



4.1 Arrivals – Receipts

In 2022, inbound visitor flows decreased by -11.2%, with 27,836 thousand visitors compared to 31,348 thousand visitors in 2019. In the period under review, the number of visitors from within the EU27 came to 16,995 thousand, showing a decrease of -8.4% compared to 2019, while the number of visitors from outside the EU27 decreased by -15.3% and came to 5,428 thousand. The number of visitors from within the euro area increased by +4.5%, while the number of visitors from EU27 countries outside the euro area decreased by -27.5%. More specifically, the visitor flow from Germany increased by +8.1% with 4,352 thousand visitors, while the flow from France increased by +14.0% with 1,758 thousand visitors. With regard to non-EU27 countries, the visitor flow from the United Kingdom increased by +28.2% with 4,485 thousand visitors, while the flow from the United States decreased by -7.7% with 986 thousand visitors. Finally, the visitor flow from Russia decreased by -93.8% with the number of visitors coming to 36 thousand.

In 2022, travel receipts decreased by -3.0% compared to 2019 and amounted to €17,631 million. This development was due to a \pm 3.7% increase in receipts from residents of the EU27 (amounting to €9,978 million) and to an -8.8% decrease in receipts from residents of non-EU27 countries (amounting to €7,246 million). Overall, receipts are €548 million less than in 2019. Of these, €392 million are attributable to the loss of the Russian market, €91 million to a decrease in cruise revenues and €64.1 million from other activity.

Specifically, receipts from euro area residents amounted to $\le 8,020$ million, up by +3.7%%, while receipts from EU27 residents outside the euro area came to $\le 1,959$ million, for a decrease of -2.0%.

More specifically, receipts from Germany increased by +10.0% and amounted to €3,255 million, and receipts from France by +16.4%, amounting to €1,268 million. Of non-EU27 countries, receipts from the United Kingdom showed an increase of +21.8%, amounting to €3,123 million. Receipts from the USA also increased, by +0.6%, and amounted to €1,196 million, while receipts from Russia decreased by -90.5% and amounted to €41 million.

In conclusion, the UK presented the greatest increase (21.8% in revenues and +28.2% in visitor numbers), followed by France (+16.4%/+14.0%) and Germany (+10.0%/+8.1%). It is noteworthy that UK residents showed a decrease in the Spending Per Person (SPP) when compared to residents of France, Germany and the USA, who showed an increase. A marginal increase in revenues (+0.6%) was seen from USA residents, despite a decrease in arrivals of -7.7%.



Despite an increase in revenues and visitor numbers from euro area countries (+3.7%/+4.5%), they presented a decrease in SPP; the converse was true for non-euro area countries (-2.0%/-27.5%) and non-EU countries (-8.8%/-15.3%), for which the SPP was higher despite the decrease.

Finally, based on the Frontier Survey, SPP rose by +9.7% in 2022 to €619 compared to €564 in 2019.

5 Accommodation Services



5.1 Greek hotel activity

5.1.1 Change in revenue in selected accommodations

A +14.3% increase in revenue was recorded in 2022 compared to 2019 (*Graph 5*). A decrease was recorded for the period January-April, and an increase for the period May-December. More specifically, a -52.8% decrease was recorded in January and a -48.9% decrease in February. The decrease slowed in March and came to -31.7%, and was just -3.0% in April. An increase was recorded for the first time in May at +13.2%, while June showed a +17.6% increase. In July, the increase came to +19.1%, in August to only +19.5% and in September to +19.4%. The highest increase (+25.6%) was recorded in October. Finally, the increase in November was +15.7% and +15.3% in December.




Chart 4: Change in Revenue in Selected Accommodations – 2022 relative to 2019

5.1.2 Arrivals of residents and non-residents in hotels and similar establishments, camping grounds and collective short-stay accommodation establishments

For the period January-September 2022, an +87.0% increase in arrivals was recorded across all hotels and similar establishments, camping grounds and collective short-stay accommodation establishments compared to the same period in 2021. (Table 13). More specifically, arrivals of non-residents showed a +102.0% increase while arrivals of residents showed a +51.0% increase. The largest share of arrivals in hotels and similar establishments pertained to non-residents (16.8 million), while arrivals of residents came to 5.3 million. A similar picture was observed in short-stay accommodation establishments, with arrivals of residents coming to 1.3 million and arrivals of non-residents coming to 4.4 million.

5.1.3 Nights spent by residents and non-residents in hotels and similar establishments, camping grounds and collective short-stay accommodation establishments

For the period January-September 2022, a +89.1% increase in nights spent was recorded across all hotels and similar establishments, camping grounds and collective short-stay accommodation establishments compared to the same period in 2021 (*Table 14*). More specifically, the number of nights spent by non-residents showed a +100.8% increase while the number of nights spent by residents showed a +40.8% increase. The largest number of nights spent in hotels and similar establishments pertains to non-residents (79.4 million), while the number of nights spent by residents was 12.6 million. A similar picture was observed in short-stay accommodation establishments, with nights spent by residents coming to 4.6 million and non-residents to 22.7 million.

6 Quality Ratings

6.1 Quality ratings for Greece

Table 15 shows the Global Review Index (GRI) for Greece for the years 2022, 2021 and 2019. In 2022, Greece's GRI for hotels was at 87.0% compared to 87.1% in 2019. It is worth noting that the majority of individual ratings for hotels improved during 2022 compared to 2019, apart from the categories of Food and Drink, and Entertainment. Three ratings were higher than the GRI: the ratings for Cleanliness (91.2%), Service (89.7%) and Location (87.3%). The Value for Money rating came to 84.9% and the Room rating to 84.6%. The Food and Drink rating came in lower at 83.5%. The only rating that came in under 80% was for Entertainment, with 76.7%.

6.2 GRI - The topic cloud

The topic cloud (Graph 6) provides a quick and visual way to identify the key drivers that are affecting the GRI. The bigger the word, the higher the volume of reviews for this driver; the darker the green, the more positive the rating; the darker the red, the more negative; and the darker the orange, the more neutral the rating. They show some obvious topics, such as sources of comments: Booking, Google, Tripadvisor, etc. We can also see keywords that signal visitors' positive attitude, depending on the type of visitor ('Couple', 'Family' and 'Solo') and the visitor's country of origin ('United Kingdom', 'German', 'France', 'Greek', etc.). However, what definitely stands out are the positive comments about hotels and services which were widely discussed online in 2022, such as 'Service', 'Room', 'Location', 'Value' and 'Cleanliness'.

6.3 Main Categories with Positive Mentions

The top-10 main thematic categories that generated the most positive online mentions for 2022 resulted from the semantic analysis of the comments (*Table 16*). It is worth noting that, as regards the categories that appear in the top-10 positive mentions and in the top-18 negative mentions, positive mentions are significantly more than the negative ones. In first place, with 193 thousand mentions, is the Food and Drink category, with most positive mentions containing the keyword 'breakfast'. This was followed by the Establishment category with 106 thousand mentions, most of which contained the word 'hotel'. The Staff category generated more than 103 thousand positive mentions. This was followed by the Experience category (85 thousand mentions) and the Cleanliness category (69 thousand mentions). There were approximately 41 thousand positive mentions for the Beach category, with most mentions containing the keyword 'sea'. In seventh place was the Service category (31 thousand mentions), followed by the Entertainment category (31 thousand mentions), with 'animation team' being the main keyword. Ninth place was taken by the Ambience category, with the keyword 'quiet' and 29 thousand mentions. Finally, 10th place was taken by the Spa category, with the keyword 'massage' and 8 thousand mentions.

6.4 Main Categories with Negative Mentions

The top-18 of the main thematic categories that generated the greatest number of negative online mentions for 2022 resulted from the semantic analysis of the comments (*Table 17*). In first place was the Food and Drink category – with 55 thousand mentions – with most negative mentions containing the keyword 'drink'. This was followed by the Room category with 46 thousand mentions, most of which contained the keyword "air conditioning". The Facilities category came next, with 26 thousand mentions and 'water' as the keyword. The negative mentions containing the word 'water' specifically referred to freezing water in swimming pools, poor swimming pool maintenance, and the lack of hot water in the bathroom during the stay. The Establishment category generated more than 25 thousand negative mentions, with the main keyword being 'building'.

The Cleanliness category occupied fifth place, with 21 thousand mentions and 'dirty' as the key driver. The Ambience category followed in sixth place with 18 thousand mentions and 'noise' as the keyword. In seventh place with 18 thousand mentions was the Value category, with 'payment' as the keyword. The Bathroom category followed with 17 thousand mentions.

There were 12 thousand negative mentions in the Experience category, with most mentions containing the keyword 'visitor'. The Staff category was next with 11 thousand mentions; the main keyword was 'communication', mainly referring to the difficulties in communicating with the staff primarily because of their poor use of English, but also of German. The Location category came in at 11th place with 10 thousand mentions and with most negative mentions containing the keyword 'taxi', pertaining to the lack of connection to ports and airports.

This was followed by the Entertainment category with 9 thousand mentions, most of which contained the keyword 'music', either referring to its being too loud or not available. In 13th place was the Bed category, with 8 thousand negative mentions of 'mattresses'. The Service category drew 8 thousand negative mentions, with the keyword 'line'. The Decoration category was in 15th place with the keyword 'furniture' (relative to its age).In 16th place was the Maintenance category, with almost 7 thousand negative mentions referring to 'broken', followed by the Reception category, with almost 7 thousand negative mentions about 'communication with reception'. Finally, in 18th place was the Beach category, with 7 thousand negative mentions.

6.5 Travel Type based on Comment Analysis

About 80% of comments derive from two travel type categories (*Graph 7*): 47% relate to couple travel and 33% to family travel. Solo travellers account for 11% of comments, while group travellers account for 7%. Finally, business trips only account for 3% of comments.

6.6 Top-10 Comment Sources

There were two main comment sources for 2022: Booking (54%) and Google (26%) (*Chart 8*). Tripadvisor was in third place (11%), while other sources account for less than 5%. HolidayCheck accounts for 3%, Expedia for 2% and Hotels.com, Facebook and Check24 for 1%, respectively. Finally, TUI (0.4%) and Agoda (0.3%) complete the top-10. Note that the top-10 represent nearly all sources.




Chart 7: Top-10 Sources

6.7 Net Promoter Score

The Net Promoter Score for all of 2022 in all star hotel categories and most regional units remains high (greater than 30). The NPS was at high levels in three regional units, such as Crete, the Cyclades and the Dodecanese, which receive the largest volume of tourists. Specifically in the Cyclades at the start of the tourist season (April-May) and at the end (November), the NPS remained at high levels (more than 70), while for the period June-October it ranged from 58 to 68. Conversely, for the Ionian Islands, at peak tourist season in August, the NPS dropped to just 28. Two more cases of a low NPS were recorded in the regional unit of North Aegean, with 30 in January and just 19 in April 2022.

In 2019, the NPS score shows that customer satisfaction was at a consistently high level (>30) throughout the year, with a positive differentiation in the regional unit of the Cyclades at the beginning and end of the season (May and October 2021), when the NPS score was very high (71).

7 Workforce Survey



7.1 Accommodation and food service activities

During the first quarter of 2022, 323 thousand employees were recorded as working in accommodation and food services, showing a +0.3% increase compared to 2019. In the second quarter, the decrease in the number of employees was -0.5%, with 401 thousand employees recorded compared to 403 thousand for the corresponding quarter in 2019. The third quarter was a period of recovery, with 445 thousand employees being recorded, showing an increase of +3.7% compared to 2019 (429 thousand).




Chart10: Employee progress in accommodation and food services

8 Car Rentals



8.1 Users of the car rental market

The services provided by the car rental sector are considered essential for almost all types of a country's tourism development. In Greece, the car rental sector has been operating as part of broader tourism development for the last 40 years. Car rentals decreased dramatically in 2020 due to the restrictive measures in response to the COVID-19 outbreak while, according to estimates, sales are expected to reach prepandemic levels in 2023-24.

According to the data in Chart 12, it is estimated that the number of users in Greece in 2022 came to 753 thousand, compared to 772 thousand in 2021, for a marginal decrease of -2%. The highest rate was recorded in 2019, where the number of users amounted to 1.1 million. Overall in 2022, users decreased by -30% compared to 2019.




Chart 11: Users of the Car Rental Market

8.2 Car rental activity

Revenues from car rentals in 2022 came to \le 185 million compared to \le 182 million in 2021 for an increase of +2%. The highest rate was recorded in 2019, where revenue from car rentals amounted to \le 260 million. Overall in 2022, revenues decreased by -29% compared to 2019.




Chart 12: Revenue from Car Rentals in million euros

8.3 Car rental channels

Online sales showed an increase in 2022, compared to 2021. In 2022 the share of online sales stood at 46%, compared to 54% for offline sales. Online sales have been rising since 2017, but at a very slow rate. Indicatively, in 2017 the share of online sales stood at 43%, compared to 57% for offline sales.

Notes and clarifications of the data in tables and graphs

International airport arrivals: The data show arrivals of passengers on international flights, irrespective of their domicile. As regards the data for Athens International Airport, given the disruptions of the survey and/or the small sample size during the period March 2020-June 2021, the respective passenger volume estimates should be treated with caution and comparisons should be avoided. Airports are classified as follows: Dodecanese: Rhodes - Kos - Karpathos, Crete: Heraklion - Chania, Ionian: Corfu - Zakynthos - Kefalonia - Aktio, Cyclades: Mykonos - Santorini, Peloponnese: Araxos - Kalamata, Other: Samos - Skiathos - Kavala - Lesvos.

<u>Domestic arrivals at main Greek airports:</u> Passengers travelling round trip are counted twice: both when arriving at their destination and when returning home. The data for the last available month for Athens International Airport are an estimate of INSETE Intelligence. Airports are classified as follows: Dodecanese: Rhodes - Kos - Karpathos, Crete: Heraklion - Chania, Ionian: Corfu - Zakynthos - Kefalonia - Aktio, Cyclades: Mykonos - Santorini - Paros, Other: Samos - Skiathos - Kavala - Lesvos.

<u>Road arrivals:</u> Road arrivals are recorded by the local police departments based on nationality, irrespective of the permanent domicile. Consequently, the data include immigrants in Greece returning from trips abroad. Countries are classified as follows: Albania: Kakavia - Krystallopigi - Sagiada - Mertzani, Bulgaria: Ormenio - Kyprinos - Nymphaea - Promachonas - Exochi - Agios Konstantinos, Republic of North Macedonia: Evzoni - Doirani - Niki, Turkey: Kastanies - Kipoi.

ReviewPro quality ratings: The tables show the GRI® for hotel guests as calculated by ReviewPro®, a company which specializes in measuring the online reputation of hotels. This index is calculated for each hotel, through the analysis of variables linked to customer comments which are posted on hundreds of social network platforms, hotel review websites, and websites of OTAs (online travel agents). Apart from daily reviews, it also takes into account the historical data for the past 365 days, thus adding more weight to the more recent reviews. A rating of over 80% suggests a positive experience. The index is qualitative and can be used to evaluate the progress of the quality of services provided. For the purposes of calculation, data on 1,126 hotels of various categories and different regions of Greece have been analysed.

<u>Arrivals based on the Bank of Greece Border Survey:</u> The figures are estimates based on a sample survey, and pertain to arrivals of residents of other countries, irrespective of the travel mode (air, road, sea) and regardless of nationality, i.e. they include Greek nationals permanently residing abroad but do not include foreign nationals permanently residing in Greece.

Receipts based on the Bank of Greece Border Survey: The Border Survey estimates receipts based on a sample survey among residents of other countries who visit Greece.

<u>GBR</u>: The sample consisted of 200 hotels and the revenue index was based on room revenue for Thessaloniki and Athens hotels and on total revenues for hotels in other regions.



ELSTAT: Data on guest arrivals and nights spent in hotels and similar establishments and camping grounds in Greece are collected through the Survey on Arrivals and Nights spent in Hotels, Similar Establishments and Camping Grounds, which is carried out on a monthly basis through the completion of a special form by each establishment for every month of its operation. All hotels and similar establishments and camping grounds in Greece are required to provide the aforementioned statistical data. This is a census survey which is carried out on a monthly basis. Results are arrived at through the collection and processing of the relevant data submitted via a specific questionnaire by hotels, similar establishments and camping grounds for each month of operation. The questionnaires are mostly submitted electronically via ELSTAT's electronic application 'Xenios Zeus' or, alternatively, for establishments where this is not possible, in paper form. The survey is based on the Statistical Register of hotels, similar establishments and camping grounds, which is updated from administrative sources in the course of the year so that data pertain to the actual number of accommodation establishments and camping grounds that are in operation.

Employment figures (number of employees, unemployed, etc.) are estimated through the use of a suitable unbiased estimator, which takes account of: a) the probability of selection of the sample households, b) the households' response rate in every primary sampling unit (area), c) the population distribution by gender and age group in every Region and d) the distribution of private household numbers throughout Greece. As of January 2021, survey data are collected by means of an online questionnaire. Economic activities are classified on the basis of the product that is produced or the service that is provided. Since 2008, STAKOD 08 has been used, which is identical to NACE Rev2. The Labour Force Survey collects data based on the three-digit level for the main job and on the two-digit level for the second and previous job.

Hellenic Ports Association: The Hellenic Ports Association releases aggregate arrival and passenger data for the Greek cruise industry.

<u>SEEN:</u> The Association of Passenger Shipping Companies (SEEN) presents estimates of the number of passengers for the Adriatic market and of domestic maritime flows.

<u>Statista:</u> The Car Rental section includes vehicle rentals booked in person, by phone, through the internet or an application. Users represent people who have booked a trip, regardless of number of travellers. This section takes into account the rental agreements based on time with advance payment of fixed charges by professional car rental services, such as SIXT, Hertz and Budget. The following are not included: carpools, chauffeur services, taxis or ride sharing offers using invoice models based on use or offers.
